



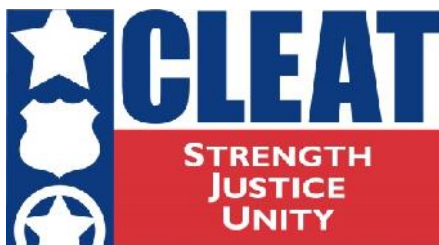

Why is this course needed?

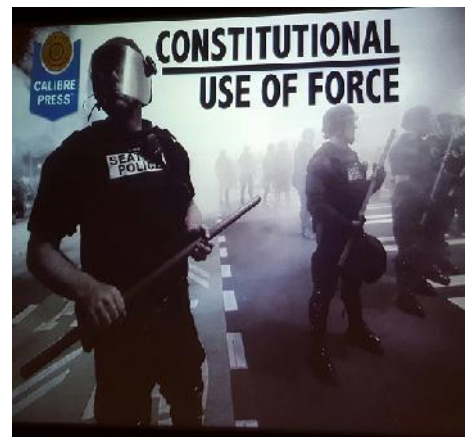
