- 8:30 - 9:15 am **Shootout in Steubenville: Court Officer Saves Judge from Attempted Assassination**

A gripping reconstruction of the assassination attempt against Jefferson County Judge Bruzzese by a gunman in Steubenville on August 21, 2017. This murder was **foiled when a tactically minded court officer** killed the would-be assassin with gunfire at close quarters just steps from the courthouse across from City Hall. The severely wounded Judge was armed and returned fire at his assailant. Another judge who was a former registered nurse provided field treatment of the judge's gunshot wounds on the sidewalk. All of these heroic actions combined to save the Judge's life. This is the second Case Study in the Ohio Court Officer Safety & Survival Series.

Option 1 - Close Quarters Handgun Tactics for Court Officers (Session Limited to 36)

Court officers will be instructed and drilled to engage targets at close quarters with their duty pistols and perform holster drills, practice reloads, reduce stoppages, and transition to and from other weapons to their handguns. Courses of fire will incorporate scenarios from case studies.

Option 2 - Southern Ohio Correctional Facility Tour (Session Limited to 50)

The Southern Ohio Correctional Facility is a maximum-security prison located just outside Lucasville in Scioto County. The prison was constructed in 1972. Learn about the longest prison siege in Ohio history and view death chambers.
